	<p><u>Memorial Stone – JD</u> A detailed discussion took place over a request for the above memorial stone as elements of the request were either beyond the predefined rules or contained imagery questionable for a public graveyard.</p> <p>It was proposed by DB and seconded by CE to refuse permission for the fighting scenes to be included on the memorial stone however due to the particularly tragic nature of this bereavement some flexibility could be allowed to the existing rules specifically the inclusion of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a narrow 6" base to the headstone - a max of 3x additional cartoon characters (up to 6" tall and to be on the front face of the memorial stone) <p>All other details were approved as they met existing rules</p> <p style="text-align: right;">MAJORITY</p> <p>It was also agreed to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - suggest to the family that they might consider installing the requested graphics on the new memorial bench - accept any remaining contributions from the Co-op to help in the upkeep of the bench.
