It was suggested by DB that the previous decision not to accept contributions from IYFC and ICC clubs was based on the clubs expectations regarding the extended time frame for use of the shed. It was proposed by DB and seconded by LW that the payments would only be accepted on the basis that it would be used to directly offset their rental use of the playing fields for the next two years.

As considered at the recent finance committee, it was proposed by DB and seconded by GP that the charge for rental space in the new tractor shed would be £7.81 pm2.
