#### **4. ALLOTMENT MATTERS**

##### Allotment Rules

It was proposed by Cllr Cave and seconded by Cllr Mrs Gannon that the allotment rules be amended to include the following:

The Tenant may not use the allotment for any use other than horticultural without permission from the Council.

Dogs belonging to allotment holders must be kept on a lead or tethered on the allotment holders own plot.

Chickens may only be kept after permission has been given by the Council.

Tenants are free to park off the road on a section of their own allotment but there are to be no hard standings.

The allotment roadway is for access to allotments only.

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Subject to water being available on site in the future the standpipes CAN ONLY be used for filling watering cans or appropriate receptacles. Under no circumstances are they to be connected to hosepipes.

The Tenant can only burn organic waste produced from their own allotment. This should be dead or dried material only. The burning of any artificial substances is strictly forbidden.
