Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Isleham Neighbourhood Area

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday 28 April 2022 to decide on the question below:

“Do you want East Cambridgeshire District Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Isleham to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote must reach The Electoral Registration Officer at The Grange Nutholt Lane Ely Cambs CB7 4EE by 12 midnight on 8 April 2022
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes, or amendments to proxy votes, or asking for a postal proxy vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Grange Nutholt Lane Ely Cambs CB7 4EE by 5pm on 11 April 2022
4. New Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Grange Nutholt Lane Ely Cambs CB7 4EE by 5pm on 20 April 2022
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Grange Nutholt Lane Ely Cambs CB7 4EE by 5pm on Thursday 28 April 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service the person must have become aware that they cannot go to a polling station in person after 5pm on 20 April 2022.
