CASUAL VACANCY

1. Notice is hereby given of a vacancy in the office of Parish Councillor in the parish of Isleham.
2. Forms of Application may be requested from the Proper Officer, The beeches, 32 Mill Street Isleham CB7 5RY, Telephone no. 01638 781687 or via email: islehampc@gmail.com
3. Completed Application Forms must be received by the Proper Officer no later than Tuesday 28th November 2017.

To qualify for election to a Parish Council, a person, unless disqualified by virtue of the Local Government Act 1972 or any other enactment, must on the day of election be a British subject or citizen of the European Union or Ireland and attained the age of 21 years and

- (a) on that day is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority; or
- (b) has during the whole of the twelve months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the area; or
- (c) his or her principal or only place of work during that twelve months has been in the area; or
- (d) has during the twelve months resided in that area; or
- (e) during the whole twelve months has resided in the Parish or within 4.8 Kilometres (three miles) of it.

Disqualification from being elected a member is set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.
